"Living in Hope," 1 Peter

Peter wrote his first letter to believers who were experiencing trouble. He reminded them that God had charted their course and their destination was sure. In it God wants to give you His perspective and power to stay on course and deal with every difficult circumstance. Peter reminds us that the secret to cope is living in hope.

"Growing in Hope," 2 Peter

Peter wrote his second letter with the urgency of a man whose days were numbered. He wrote to say remember.... remember all that God has done for you. Remember the truth you've been given. Remember what the future holds for you. Keep growing in the knowledge of the One who gives you hope.

"Proclaiming Love," 1 John

What is the first thing you do when you walk into a dark room? You look for the light. Light keeps us from stumbling and bumping into obstacles in darkness. Light helps us to see where we're going. John writes this letter to tell us that Jesus is the Light and that He is Love.

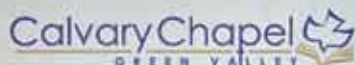
Opportunities to Serve
